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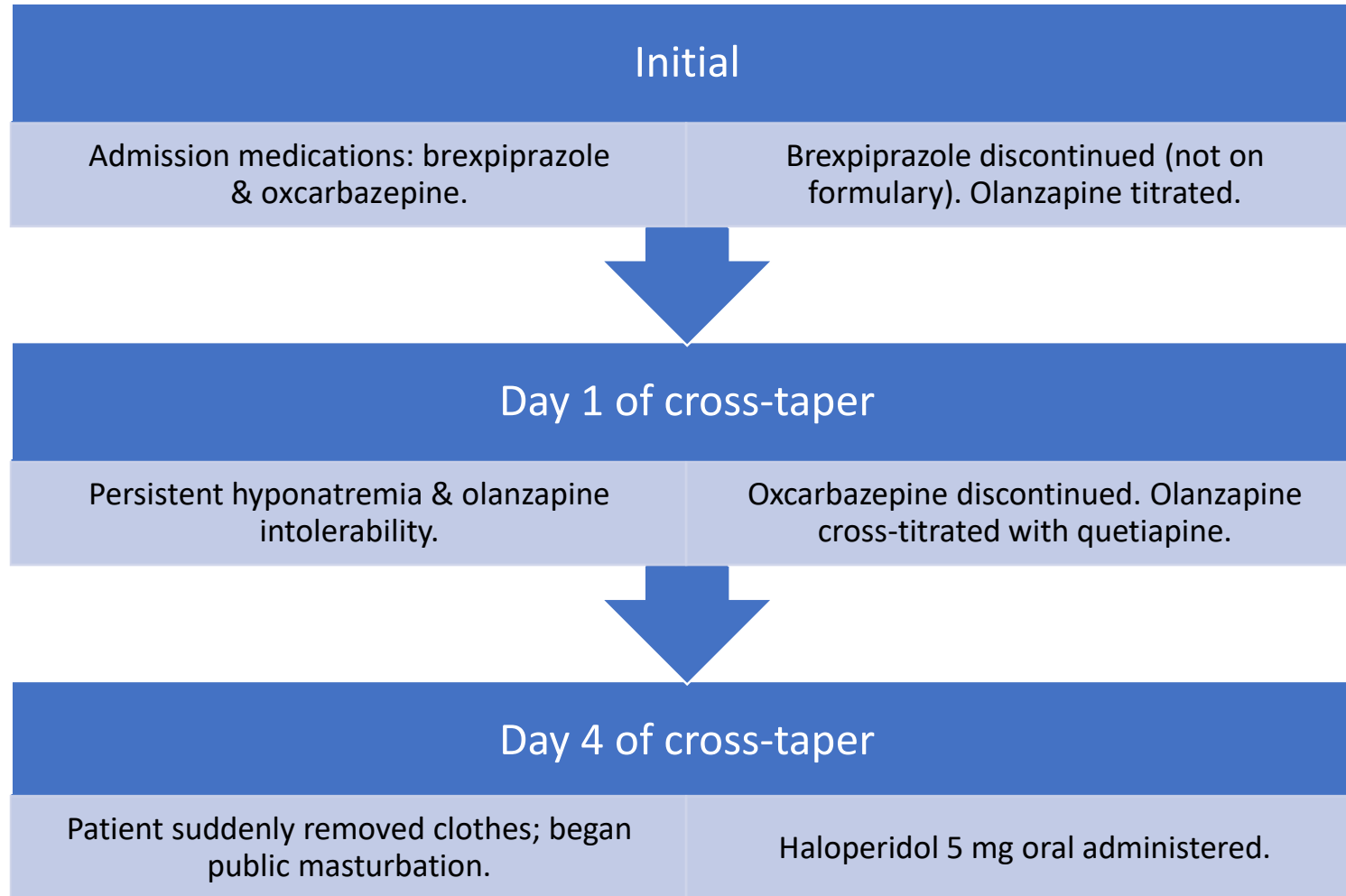

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Supplementary Figure 1. The Patient's Hospital Course



2-4 hours later

Patient extremely diaphoretic & confused with muscle rigidity. HR 150 bpm, BP 155/90. CPK 518 $\mu\text{g/L}$.

Lorazepam 2 mg IV administered.

1 hour later

Patient transferred to emergency department.

All NMS-like symptoms resolved.

Return to inpatient facility

Patient continued to demonstrate emotional lability and paranoia.

Clozapine titration led to symptom reduction without further incidents.
